The identification of potential players and the pathway from beginners to a representative player will be an integral part of this role. Leveraging the Badminton World Federation training platform which includes Shuttle Time and Badminton World Federation coaching courses, the Development Officer will also be responsible for the development of coaches in clubs and schools, thus building our base of people that can deliver quality coaching to all players.

The suitable person should have good written and verbal communication skills as they will be dealing with a wide range of people, including children, teachers, sports administrators, principals, and parents.

A good rapport with children is very important, as are strong administration skills, as there are various reports and administrative requirements in this role.
