Rules & Regulations

- a) The competition runs for three evenings (18, 20 & 27 July) with the finals evening on Friday 5 August.
- b) The competition is open to grades A, B & C.
- c) Players enter individually, indicating their events and partners (doubles/mixed) i.e. each person must submit an entry. One of a pair cannot enter on behalf of their partner.
- d) The entry fee is detailed above and must be paid for when you submit your entry via paypal.
- e) To enter this competition you must be a registered member of Badminton North Harbour (club member)
- f) Players must indicate their grade on the entry form based on the criteria below. If you won your grade in 2021 you will play in the next grade up (except A grade winners). Badminton North Harbour reserves the right to re-grade a player if deemed necessary.
- g) Each player/pair is placed into a round robin box. The size of this box will be determined by the number of entries.
- h) Scoring shall be the best of three (3) games to 21 points with extension. If the number of players in a pool box is greater than four (4) an alternative scoring system may be used. This will be advised before the competition begins.
- i) **Competition Results: BWF Ranking for Events Played under the Pool System**
As recommended by BNZ for all individual events played under a Round Robin format
 - i. Ranking will be established by the number of matches won
 - ii. If two players/pairs have won the same number of matches, the winner of the match between them will be ranked higher
 - iii. If three or more players/pairs have won the same number of matches ranking will be decided by the difference between total games won and total games lost, with greater difference ranked higher. If this leaves two players/pairs equal, ranking will be decided by the result of the match between them.
 - iv. If three or more players/pairs have won the same number of matches and are equal in the difference between total games won and total games lost, ranking will be established by the difference between total points won and total points lost, with greater difference ranked higher. If this still leaves two players/pairs equal, ranking will be decided by the result of the match between them.
 - v. If three or more players/pairs are still equal, then ranking will be established by drawing lots

A Grade	Division 1-4; Masters 1; Veterans 1; u17 I; u19 I team, Senior Squad members & relevant players to this grade
B Grade	Division 5; Masters 2-3; Veterans 2; u17 II, u19 II, Development Squad members & relevant players to this grade
C Grade	Masters 4; Super Veterans 1 and relevant players to this grade
