

2025 INTERCLUB COMPETITION OVERVIEW Interclub Starts Monday 4 August

There will be an A, B, & C mixed grade competition plus a separate Men's League. Clubs are to grade their own players. The success or otherwise of the competition is very reliant on clubs naming players in the correct grade. There is also the possibility of composite teams if clubs have excess players that they are unable to place in a team. BNH reserves the right to re-grade a player if they deem that player to be in the wrong team. The table below is a guideline to assist you with grading your players.

A Grade	Division 1-4, Masters 1, Masters 2, Top Vets 1 and U19 Rep's, Top U17 Rep's. Non Reps as graded by BNH
B Grade	Masters 3, Masters 4, top Masters 5 & Vets 1 & Vet's 2, Top Vet's 3, U17 & Top U15 Rep's. Non Reps as graded by BNH
C Grade	Masters 5 team & Vet's teams 3 & 4; Super Vets, U15 Rep's, Non Reps as graded by BNH
C Grade	Non representatives who do not meet any of the above guidelines.

The Draw

Graded Interclub

A, B & C Mixed Grade

- Six matches per tie
- 3 men; 1 woman
- 6 doubles matches
- 1 court per tie

Mens League (if sufficient players) – 2 Divisions (Division 1 A/B, Division 2 C/D)

- Teams to consist of 4 men
- A tie will include 6 doubles
- A total of 6 matches
- Each tie will be allocated 1 court

Scoring:

All matches in all events will be the **best of three games to 15 points with extension to 21** if required. We are trialing the proposed scoring system that the BWF have indicated may come into play in the near future.

Cost:

A, B, C Grade - \$72 per tie Mens League = \$72 per tie

Clubs will be invoiced for all ties in one invoice once the draw has been confirmed. Clubs withdrawing their teams following the publication of the draw will be eligible for the cost of their tie fees.

Please remember: If clubs are unable to place all players, these can be submitted to us at BNH and we will try to form composite teams.
