Team Management

All schools must have an adult with them during the competition. This person is responsible for players to be where they need to be, when they need to be there. They must also be aware of any medical problems of players and supervise the players when they are not on court.

Fees

\$10 per singles player

\$10 per doubles pair

Badminton North Harbour will invoice the schools once the competition has concluded.

Teams that withdraw after the entry closing date will still be liable for the entry fee.

Uniforms

School sport uniforms appropriate to the sport must be worn.

Non marking shoes only to be worn.



NORTH HARBOUR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL ZONE DAY 2025 STRUCTURE/RULES

Interpretation

All matches shall be played in accordance with the rules of the New Zealand Badminton Federation. Contest shall mean the total matches between players in any one section.

Match shall mean one singles and/or one doubles between members of opposing teams.

Contest

A contest shall consist of singles and/or one doubles match.

Players can compete in both singles and/or doubles, however total entries are limited.

In 2025, each school can enter four (4) singles players and two (2) doubles pair per day.

Singles will begin at 9.15am with doubles following no earlier than 11.30am.

Matches

A match shall consist of one game up to 21 points for boys and girls.

Umpiring

All matches must be umpired by players in the competition.

Supervisors are not entitled to interfere with line calling in a match but, if necessary, may help the umpire with scoring.

Format

Players will participate in round robin boxes with stage two determined by the number of players entered. The final stage will be confirmed and communicated to schools before the day of play.

Points as per BWF Round Robin System

Ranking will be established by the number of matches won

ii. If two players/pairs have won the same number of matches, the winner of the match between them will be ranked higher

iii. If three or more players/pairs have won the same number of matches ranking will be decided by the difference between total games won and total games lost, with greater difference ranked higher. If this leaves two players/pairs equal, ranking will be decided by the result of the match between them.

iv. If three or more players/pairs have won the same number of matches and are equal in the difference between total games won and total games lost, ranking will be established by the difference between total points won and total points lost, with greater difference ranked higher. If this still leaves two players/pairs equal, ranking will be decided by the result of the match between them.

v. If three or more players/pairs are still equal, then ranking will be established by drawing lotS

Qualification of Players

A player must be currently attending the school he/she is representing.

Result Sheets

Results are to be recorded on the sheets provided.

Shuttles

Badminton North Harbour will provide feather shuttles.

Any player found intentionally damaging a shuttle will be charged \$5 for a replacement.

Defaults

Defaults must be notified to Badminton North Harbour by phone 021 477794 or email <u>lisa@bnh.org.nz</u> by 5pm the day prior to the day of competition at the latest. If a player is unable to attend due to illness, a replacement can be made.

Medals

Medals will be awarded to all winners and runners-up.
