North Harbour u13/u15 Non-Rep Tournament - Conditions of Entry 2025

GENERAL

- 1. It is expected that players will have read and agreed with the 'Conditions of Entry' prior to submitting an entry.
- 2. Players are eligible to compete if they have NOT represented any association at the New Zealand Junior Team National Championships in 2025.
- 3. All matches in the round robin and championship draws will be best of 3 games, to 15 points. Any Division 2 matches will be 1 game to 21 points.
- 4. Players will be entitled to a minimum break of 15 minutes between matches.
- 5. All questions as to the rules shall be resolved by an appointed tournament official.
- 6. RSL Standard shuttles will be used.
- 7. There will be one plate event in each event at this tournament if numbers are sufficient. Plate entry is automatic for the losers of their first match. Players wishing to withdraw must advise the Tournament Director immediately after their first match loss. If a player defaults, withdraws or retires (does not complete) their first match, they are not eligible for the plate.
- 8. The draw will be made on Thursday 6 November 2025. This and the first day's schedule will be available on the Badminton North Harbour website on Friday 7 November 2025.
- 9. The tournament director and/or Referee reserve the right to:
 - Cancel any event in which fewer than 8 entries are received, or if time does not permit a full competition to be played.
 - Default a player who is not available to play at the scheduled time.

PLAYER REQUIREMENTS

- 11. Players must obtain permission to leave the hall.
- 12. Players will be defaulted if they are not on court ready to play within two minutes of being called.
- 13. Players must wear badminton clothing and non-marking indoor shoes.
- 14. All players must act as umpires or line judges when requested. Failure to do so may result in the player being defaulted. Please check the websites prior to the session for player umpires (if needed).
- 15. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during this tournament.
- 16. Following warnings for misconduct, the Referee shall have the authority to disqualify a player from further play if there is a repeat of serious misconduct.
- 17. U13 entry criteria players must be born in 2013, and within or before 2017.

18. U15 entry criteria – players must be born in 2011, and within or before 2017

ENTRY DETAILS

18. Entry can only be made online and must be received no later than 23:59 on Wednesday 29 October 2025.

Online entry can be made through www.bnh.org.nz.

- 19. Entries for doubles will not be accepted unless full payment is received from both partners by the close of entries. This excludes 'partner required' entries. It is not the responsibility of Badminton North Harbour to follow up entries from nominated, un-entered partners.
- 20. Players withdrawing after entries have closed will not be eligible for a refund unless a medical certificate is submitted at the time of withdrawal. No refunds will be made for withdrawals after the tournament has commenced.
- 21. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during this tournament.
- 22. A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from all refunds.
- 23. Players may withdraw from individual events without being required to withdraw from all events.

SERVING

a. The whole shuttle shall be below the server's waist at the instant of being hit by the server's racket.

The waist shall be considered to be an imaginary line round the body, level with the lowest part of the server's bottom rib.

b. The shaft of the racket head of the server's racket at the instant of hitting the shuttle shall be pointing in a downward direction.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are to be paid via Paypal as part of your online entry. Entries will not be accepted into the draws until payment is made and received.

ONE EVENT: \$30.00 per player

TWO EVENTS: \$50.00 per player
