



2026 INTERCLUB COMPETITION OVERVIEW

Monday 10 August – Wednesday 23 September

There will be an A, B, & C Mixed Grade and Men’s League. Clubs are to grade their own players. The success or otherwise of the competition is very reliant on clubs naming players in the correct grade. There is also the possibility of composite teams if clubs have excess players that they are unable to place in a team. BNH reserves the right to re-grade a player if they deem that player to be in the wrong team. The table below is a guideline to assist you with grading your players.

A Grade	Division 1-4, Masters 1, Masters 2, Top Vets 1 and U19 Rep’s, Top U17 Rep’s. Non Reps as graded by BNH
B Grade	Masters 3, Masters 4, top Masters 5 & Vets 1 & Vet’s 2, Top Vet’s 3, U17 & Top U15 Rep’s. Non Reps as graded by BNH
C Grade	Masters 5 team & Vet’s teams 3 & 4; Super Vets, U15 Rep’s, Non Reps as graded by BNH

The Draw

Upon receiving club entries and the draws have been made, Badminton North Harbour will advise clubs by email. The draws will also be posted on the Badminton North Harbour website under ‘BNH Competitions’.

Entries for Badminton North Harbour Interclub will close Wednesday 29 July – no late entries will be accepted

If at least six teams are not entered into a grade, this grade may be cancelled.

Mixed Graded Interclub

A, B & C Mixed Grade

- Six matches per tie
- 3 men; 1 woman
- 3 doubles matches; 3 mixed matches
- 1 court per tie
- The women on opposing teams must play in the same place

Mens League 2 Divisions (Division 1: A/B grade, Division 2: C grade)

- Teams to consist of 4 men
- A tie will include 6 doubles
- 6 matches
- Each tie will be allocated 1 court

Scoring:

All matches in all events will be the **best of three games to 15 points with extension to 21** if required. We are trialling the new scoring system that the BWF recently passed ahead of its induction from 1 January 2027.

Cost:

All teams = \$240 per team

Clubs will be invoiced for all ties in one invoice once the draw has been confirmed. Clubs withdrawing their teams following the publication of the draw will be eligible for the cost of their team entry fee.

Please remember: If clubs are unable to place all players, these can be submitted to us at BNH and we will try to form composite teams.

Timetable

It is **proposed** that play will be on the following nights (Please note that this is subject to change dependent upon numbers entered)

Monday – B Grade Mixed/Men’s League Division 1

Wednesday – A Grade Mixed/C Grade Mixed/Men’s League Division 2

Dispensation **MUST** be sought prior to the team being entered if you have players who do not match the criteria.
